

### **WHO SHOULD SUBMIT THE NCPS-EZ (THIS FORM)?**

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The NCPS-EZ should be submitted by the noncustodial parent for all first-time financial assistance applicants whose parents are separated or divorced. This includes freshman and transfer applicants to our 2009-2010 entering class and current students wishing to apply for financial assistance at Washington University for the first time. The student and parent(s) should work together to complete the NCPS-EZ.

### **IF I SUBMIT THE CSS NONCUSTODIAL PARENT'S STATEMENT (NCPS), SHOULD I ALSO SUBMIT THE NCPS-EZ?**

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The NCPS-EZ can be completed in place of the CSS NCPS. If you have already submitted the CSS NCPS, we may ask you to send the NCPS-EZ to speed up your financial assistance application, but it is generally not necessary to complete both.

### **WHERE WILL I FIND THE INFORMATION I NEED TO COMPLETE THE NCPS-EZ?**

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Financial information used in the NCPS-EZ should come from the noncustodial parent's 2008 IRS tax returns. If the noncustodial parent has not completed the 2008 tax returns, use the line items from the 2007 returns as a guide. If you do this, give us the best estimate of what your 2008 numbers will be.

### **HOW WILL WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY DETERMINE MY ELIGIBILITY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE?**

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For students whose parents are divorced or separated, the financial assistance award is based on either the FFP-EZ or CSS PROFILE, in addition to the NCPS-EZ or CSS NCPS.

### **IS MY INFORMATION SHARED WITH OTHERS?**

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Financial information submitted to Student Financial Services is kept confidential. Your information will not be shared.
